ASK is not designed nor accredited to educate students with special needs.

Study Support Program

Elementary School: ESL reading support and resource Teacher

Middle School: Support Program for students who have the academic potential to be successful at ASK.

Students in support must have shown a sincere interest in their education and have no behavior issues.

The support class meets once every other day.

High School has no support program.

ASK provides limited resources program for students with ESL, reading, english, mathematics and study skills with additional practice and individual attention in a small group setting.

For prospective ASK Families:

If your child is known to have, or is suspected of having, learning, emotional, behavioral, or language needs the school should be notified. Upon initiating admissions process, it is important to provide clear information about your child's specific needs. We need to know if your child has or had any of the following:

- Problems with learning
- Behavior mobility, vision or hearing problems
- Requires specialized medical care, physical or speech therapy
- Needs any adaptations in the regular school routine
